Camp Cost is \$150.00 if registered by due date above. After the due date the total cost is \$160.00. A \$10 registration fee (deposit) and your Medical Release form must accompany this form and is refundable up to seven days before camp. The remaining amount is due the day of camp. There is a \$75 fee for counselors. Make checks payable to Columbia Basin Baptist Association (CBBA). Please turn forms & fees into your local CBBA church as churches arrange transportation.
